

SUPERVISION SKILLS FOR CLINICAL TEACHERS: CONVERSATIONS INVITING CHANGE

Venue: The workshops will take place at venues in central London.

This **one-day** workshop offers 'hands-on' training in the essential conversational skills needed for good supervision. In particular it addresses the issue of how to balance confirmation with challenge when supervising everyone from high fliers to doctors in difficulty. The skills taught are helpful not just in clinical supervision but also in educational supervision, mentorship and training generally.

Much of the workshop is based on participants' own working experiences. Please come expecting to talk about current cases, and dilemmas with patients, trainees, colleagues and teams.

Please note that the workshop is not a comprehensive course in how to be a clinical or educational supervisor, but will equip you with essential conversational skills for those roles. The training does not cover the contents of the Gold Guide (e.g. roles and responsibilities of educational supervisors) or the 'nuts and bolts' of MMC (e.g. curricula or work-based assessment).

Course aims:

- To explore fundamental themes in supervision
- To develop some fundamental skills in supervision

Eligibility: This workshop is available to those who are:

- within a year of completing specialist training and above
- involved in teaching or training on behalf of the London Deanery
